3	Eligibility	Required Qualification: The applicants should have a degree from any Government recognized University. Preferably, a Graduate in Social work/Sociology/ Law/ Public Administration/ Human Rights/Psychology/ Social sciences/ Child Development. Work Experience/s: (i) The individual should be a person of eminence who has made exceptional and distinguished contributions toward the promotion and welfare of children, possessing ability, integrity, and standing, with at least ten years of experience in one or more of the following fields: – (a) Education; (b) Child health, care, welfare, or child development; (c) Juvenile justice and the care of neglected, marginalized, or children with disabilities; (d) Elimination of child labour or work involving children in distress; (e) Child psychology or sociology; (f) Laws relating to children. (ii) No person having any past record of violation of human rights or child rights shall be eligible for appointment as the Chairperson /Members.
4	Age limit	The applicant should be minimum of Fifty (50) years of age and maximum of Sixty-five (65) years of age on the date for receipt of application.
5	Tenure	The Chairperson shall, unless removed from office hold office for a period not exceeding three (3) years or till the age of sixty-five (65) years, whichever is earlier.
